**GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE:** Reviews complaints by members and the public. Reviews arbitration requests to determine qualifications for hearings. (Must be Association member for two or more years for service on the Grievance Committee.)

**HOUSING COMMITTEE:** Develops programs and seminars to educate the consumer public on the home- buying process; identifies and seeks solutions to barriers of homeownership, such as credit. Develops cohesive partnerships to create a favorable environment to affordable housing. Participates in community outreach programs which create goodwill and positive publicity for our members.

**MULTIPLE LISTING COMMITTEE:** Oversees the Rules and policies governing the Multiple Listing Service. Committee members may serve on the Assessment Panel which reviews MLS violations.
